eFiling Training

The State of Arizona is moving to AZTurboCourt, a single portal for electronic filing in all Arizona state courts. Participation in e-filing through AZTurboCourt will be mandatory for most attorneys filing post-initiation civil case documents in the Superior Court in Maricopa County under the following general timetable:

2/1/2011: government, court and non-profit attorneys and attorneys in firms whose firm name begins with the letters A - E.

3/1/2011: corporate counsel and attorneys in firms whose firm name begins with the letters F - K.

4/1/2011: attorneys in firms whose firm name begins with the letters L - R.

5/1/2011: attorneys in firms whose firm name begins with the letters S - Z, solo practitioners and other attorneys not listed above, unless exempt.

Free training is also offered on how to efile documents in the Superior Court in Maricopa County using the Clerk of the Court's **eFiling Online** website, which is limited to civil eFilings not mandated to be filed through AZTurboCourt, Criminal pleadings and in a limited number of Family Court divisions that are accepting eFilings.
