## **eFiling in tax cases is moving to AZTurboCourt in October and November**

**Beginning October 13, 2014**, attorney-filed documents in Tax cases (TX case designation) may be electronically filed through AZTurboCourt. **Effective November 3, 2014**, attorney-filed documents in Tax cases (TX case designation) must be electronically filed through AZTurboCourt. Case-initiating documents will still be filed on paper with the Clerk's Office, but subsequent documents must be filed electronically through AZTurboCourt.

The Superior Court in Maricopa County serves as the principle office of the Tax Court in Arizona for filing county and state-level challenges and appeals in the Tax Court. Small Tax cases (ST case designation) must still be filed on paper. Self-represented parties can choose to e-file through AZTurboCourt in TX cases or they may file on paper.
